The Mojaloop Accelerator is a hands-on training and mentoring program that fosters a strong network of local system integrators (SIs) to help a country achieve sovereignty and independence in their payment infrastructure.

This transformational program runs in parallel with Mojaloop Proof of Concept projects. The Mojaloop Foundation is committed to ensuring that every country that develops a Mojaloop system can independently operate and maintain its payment infrastructure. We believe this is a cornerstone of digital sovereignty.

## Benefits

Participating system integrators will:

1. Gain insights into Mojaloop from experienced practitioners.
2. Strengthen capabilities to build and maintain Mojaloop systems.
3. Develop a deeper understanding of inclusive instant payment systems, Level One principles, and **Digital Public Goods**.
4. Foster strategic partnerships by showcasing skills to a community of payment system regulators, funders, and technology companies.
5. Encourage support for Mojaloop and other **inclusive instant payment systems (IIPS)**.

## How It Works

The experience combines online training with practical learning, guided by expert mentors throughout the process. Once they've completed the initial courses, engineers and product teams will engage in concrete tasks selected from the Mojaloop Product Roadmap and a local Mojaloop Proof of Concept.

## Does Your Company Qualify?

A system integrator can be any technology services company that delivers or develops enterprise software for financial institutions. We also welcome fintech companies, innovation labs, and academic institutions to join the program if it aligns with their vision.

SIs should be based in-country and have at least:

1. Two years of experience in the local market other African countries.
2. Previous experience with financial institutions such as banks, mobile money operators, and microfinance intuitions.
3. Three people who can dedicate time to complete the activities.

## Graduation Requirements

To graduate, SIs will need to:

1. Ensure at least three (3) team members finish the Mojaloop training programs MOJA 101 - MOJA 104 and DFSP 101 - DFSP 203.
2. Engage in active participation in Mojaloop community meetings.
3. Contribute code to the Community through a project selected from the Mojaloop Roadmap.
